We are a loud band so a PA system with enough power is strongly advised.

The input list above is based on an ideal situation, where the venue and FOH desk are sufficient enough to realize this.

In smaller venues/bars with a smaller PA and FOH desk all 16 channels are not a necessity.

The microphones are put there as an indication, any quality mic comparable to the one mentioned on the input list will suffice.

We're using a Cymatic LP16 to send **backing tracks** to the FOH system and also provide in ear metronome monitoring for Martijn (drummer)


For convenience we built a rack with a Stereo DI and 1 Mono DI for Kick Trigger.

This means that the venue/organizer providing the DI's is optional, however if this is preferred we will work with the DI's provided by the venue/rental company.

Both digital guitar amps (2x Axe FX Ultra) will have two outputs:

- 1) DI Out Send to FOH
- 2) Jack output Send to onstage cabinets.
 - No need to mic up the guitar cabinets.

IMPORTANT INFO

- Kevin (Guitarist & Backing vocal) needs a Mic Stand.
- Tijn (Lead vocals) doesn't need a Mic stand.
- Martijn (Drummer) is left-handed!

Normally we will bring along drum hardware and set up cymbals backstage to keep changeover time at a minimum, unless agreed upon differently with the touring party

MONITOR PREFERENCES

Please read carefully this will make our line-check/soundcheck more fluent and swiftly.

All preferences are put into scale of 1 to 5, in which 1 indicates low and 5 high volume. This determines the importance of signal volume for each member/monitor and how loud each signal needs to be compared to others.

HOSPITALITY & REQUESTS

Parking:

If possible we would like to have the **minimum** of **3 parking places** available on the terrain of the **venue/festival terrain**. Preferably near the **loading dock**, this will make the **load in/load out** a lot more fluent and less time consuming

Travel Party:

9 persons (band: 5 and crew: 4).

If there are any changes in this amount, we will inform you asap. It might be that we don't bring (all) crew due to (private) schedule overlap.

Storage for instruments:

We would like to have a **storage/safe place** to be able to safely store our instruments. This also means we have to be able to quickly and easily get our gear when needed.

Backstage:

We would like to have a set of towels (min. 1 per member), for after the show.

Beverages and food that we request backstage

- Bottles of water (during show)
- Coca Cola/Sprite/Dr Pepper/Fanta etc..
- Beer (after-show)
- 4-6 bottles of alcohol-free beer
- 2 cans of Red Bull
- Water Boiler & tea choices
- Piece of ginger & some honey
- Min. 2 bananas

Food:

If our get in time is before 17:00 we expect a warm meal or a payout (€15,- per person) to get food locally. This buy-out will be added to the fee.

Allergies & diets:

Lactose (1 pers.) The same person also doesn't prefer to eat chicken. The band or crew doesn't follow any diets.

Stage:

Each member will need at least 2 bottles of still water ready at their spot on the stage.

Merch:

The organization will provide a spot where merchandise can be sold and our merchandise can be showcased properly.

Organization will also provide a sturdy table including a power strip.
